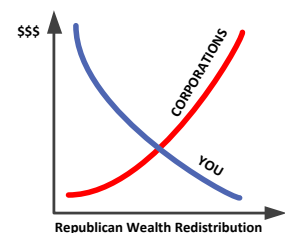
Foreclosure Fairness Act
