

33rd District Democrats General Meeting

Minutes

Monday, February 19, 2018

- I. Regular meeting of the 33rd District Democrats called to order by Chair at 7:08 pm.
- II. M/s/c to approve meeting agenda as presented.
- III. Appointment of new Board Members – Andrea Sawczuk for Secretary and Kent Palosaari for Sergeant at Arms – m/s/c by unanimous vote of members.
- IV. Call for PCOs to fill 100 positions open for filing in May. Several precincts may get boundary changes.
- V. Representative Tina Orwall reported on the Legislator’s Town Hall, Saturday, Feb. 18th and gave an update on the legislature’s short session, which ends March 8th. She announced a Tele-Town hall March 15th. She will return to present with Representative Mia Gregerson and Senator Karen Keiser at next meeting on March 19th.
- VI. King County Superior Court Judge Matt Williams provided an update of judicial positions on the ballot this year in the Washington State Supreme Court, King County Superior Court, King County District Court, U. S. Court of Appeals, and local Municipal courts.
- VII. Guest speaker Georgia Davenport, Field Director of Whole Washington Universal Healthcare Initiative I-1600 presented details of the initiative, spoke to the need for signature gatherers to meet the requirement of 300,000 signatures by July, and answered questions.
- VIII. Resolution Supporting Whole Washington Universal Healthcare Initiative I-1600 was presented to membership. M/s/c to pass the Resolution as presented, by majority vote.
- IX. Announcements and Member Action Activities:
 - A. District Caucus Planning: Chairs and committee members identified for Rules, Platform and Credentials Committees. Call will be completed by March 15th. Training for Credentials Committee tentatively scheduled for March 17th. Caucus will be held on Saturday, March 24, 10:00am, at LIUNA, regular meeting location.
 - B. South King County Democrats Spaghetti Dinner – planning meeting on March 1st for dinner tentatively scheduled to be held May 19th.
 - C. PCO Recruitment and Endorsements – Committee recommended to hold a special endorsement meeting on June 4, and continue and hopefully complete all candidate endorsements at regular meeting on June 19. Membership agreed, with a tentative plan to host all judicial candidates at one meeting and Legislative and Congressional candidates at the other meeting.
